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What is Youth in Government Day?

In 1969, the City of Anaheim started a program called Youth in Government Day to provide high school students with a better understanding of how city government plays an important role in their daily lives. Youth in Government day encourages youth participants to actively engage in meaningful dialogue and participate in activities that can help shape the City's future. The program's goal is simply to develop awareness in youth about how their city functions and assist them in becoming well informed and active citizens in their communities.

Youth in Government Day is scheduled for Wednesday, April 26, 2017.

(OPTIONAL) Mock City Council Positions

If you are interested in taking on a leadership role in Youth in Government Day either as a City Council member, City Manager, or City Clerk, please check the appropriate box on the application. Students interested in council positions and/or administrative positions should be prepared to give an interview and video speech, if selected as a finalist. Students will be given (1) key focus topic to choose from and deliver their video speech to the entire Youth in Government Day assembly on the day of the event. Students will then utilize the electoral process in determining the Mayor, Council, and Administrative positions.

Please note that you will be required to participate in an oral interview process if you seek one of the city leadership positions. Each candidate should be prepared to answer general questions regarding the City's programs and services. If you are selected, you will be notified by phone or email of your interview date and time. Interviews are tentatively scheduled for Wednesday, April 12, 2017 and the Mock City Council Workshop for Thursday, April 20, 2017. Students will be REQUIRED to attend both of these activities. This is a highly competitive process and selection of one of the above positions on your application does NOT guarantee you an interview.
